It's a sweet, generous, perfumed nose but put it in your mouth and the wine's steely dryness asserts itself. This looks the goods. There's ample flavour of lime, passionfruit, thistles, passionfruit and gravel, but as much exuberant, jubey flavour as there is – texture is the key here. It's blooming smooth. It's also drinking beautifully in its youth."
